<u>District Administrator Report</u> - Andrea Grossman

- Basic grant about \$9,000, Kathie and Andrea need to sign some documents.
- Looking into getting a webinar feature of Zoom for future presentations. At least \$690 per year. Other organizations like Sudbury Valley Trustees (SVT) use this.
 - Goal is to look more professional,
 - Have more control over what happens in our online events.
- Quarterly reports will be submitted.
- Presentation turnout results. Summary: a lot more people register than come to an event and just want the recording afterward. Point them to our YouTube channel.
- Contact form submission from Consumer Notice want us to put their information about pollinators/pesticides on our website.
- 2024 RCPP grant applicant outreach webinar, May 30th.

<u>District Conservationist Report</u> - Robert Purcell

- Conducting interviews for the Management Program Analyst position. Waiting to decide.
- Made selections last week for EQIP & CSP programs, around twenty-five applications in Middlesex, including low tunnels, irrigation & mulching. Now need to get them to pre-approved, then get signatures.
- \$3.4 million selected for EQIP applications across the state.

- Student Pathways intern will be returning in a few weeks and a second intern in Westford and a third in Holden. Pathways is a program for students to learn about the soil conservationist role and if they complete the education and hours worked requirement, they are guaranteed a soil conservationist position.
- Education outreach event in Forestry through NRCS Bob's supervisor will talk to NRCS's forestry guy.
- Austin Miles sent out Local Working Group results, but has not reviewed them yet.

- Will touch back on this next meeting.

Plant Sale

- Plant Sale Report. We made a small amount of money.
- Reimburse for Plant Sale Expenses. Altogether, expenses are about \$3,300.
- Fall plant sale:
 - Andrea reached out to the EMass Craft group to ask if anyone had a space that we could rent for a plant sale. Two responses. One in Lincoln in a barn. The other response in Sherborn has a greenhouse, organic farm.
 - Miri talked to person at Cavicchio's greenhouses.

- Can maybe sign up for wholesale code to get discounts.
- They may want to sponsor the event may donate. We will reach out to ask.
- We would select what we wanted to order in advance. There is a restocking fee if we wanted to return anything and it would have to be within 48 hours, so not really feasible.
- They have some natives, trying to increase the number of natives.
- Possibly do a tour of their facilities? Can ask.
- Margaret wants to make sure to include bulbs in the plant sale. Huge response to decorative bulbs.
 - Some mix of natives & decorative.
 - Will look at the costs of bulbs to see how we can repackage them.

Other Topics

- Want to plan a hydroponics workshop. Geared toward homes or farmers? Need to get input from Liz.
- Northeast Association of Conservation District Employees is asking for a donation.
 - Will send them \$25.
- Erosion and sediment workshop in coordination with Worcester County Conservation District (WCCD).
- Potential to attend a WCCD meeting to learn from them.
