 - Kathie & Andrea toured Farrington Nature Linc as a pickup location. Seems great, we need to make sure we put driving directions in pick up instructions. Has a barn and a workspace that we can use. Plenty of space and out of the way so it is safe. Plenty of parking. Rent would be \$1,500 (at most) for the week.
 - Can we find someone who would be willing to volunteer the space?
 - Unlikely, we have not been able to find one in many years of looking.
